Double Tabby 1: Heavy or Doubled Weft

Double Tabby / OVERSHOT DEPARTURES

Treadling system, brief instructions:

1. Pattern (very heavy, twill shed)
 2. Tabby (fine, plain weave shed)
 3. Tabby (fine, other plain weave shed)
- Etc.

Treadling/lift plan instructions for each block:

For looms with tie-ups, [use Tie-Up #1](#).

it doesn't matter which tabby shed you start with as long as they alternate throughout.

To treadle Block A:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (very heavy weft) through the Block A twill shed (Shafts 1&2 down, Shafts 3&4 up = twill treadle #1)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (fine weft) through one plain weave shed and then through the other plain weave shed.

To treadle Block B:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (very heavy weft) through the Block B twill shed (Shafts 2&3 down, Shafts 1&4 up = twill treadle #2)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (fine weft) through one plain weave shed and then through the other plain weave shed.

To treadle Block C:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (very heavy weft) through the Block C twill shed (Shafts 3&4 down, Shafts 1&2 up = twill treadle #3)



2. Throw the tabby shuttle (fine weft) through one plain weave shed and then through the other plain weave shed.

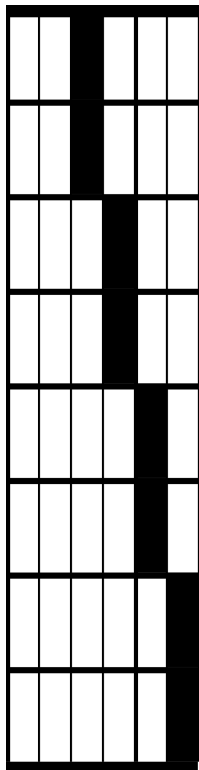
To treadle Block D:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (very heavy weft) through the Block D twill shed (Shafts 1&4 down, Shafts 2&3 up = twill treadle #4)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (fine weft) through one plain weave shed and then through the other plain weave shed.

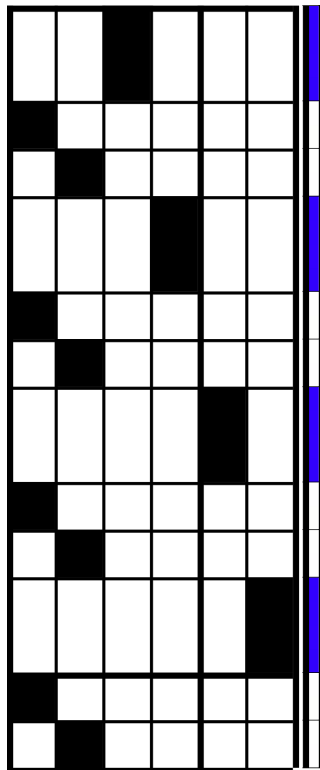
Treadling and lift plan diagrams

Note: Each pair of rows of the treadling block order represents three picks: one extra thick pattern and two tabby.

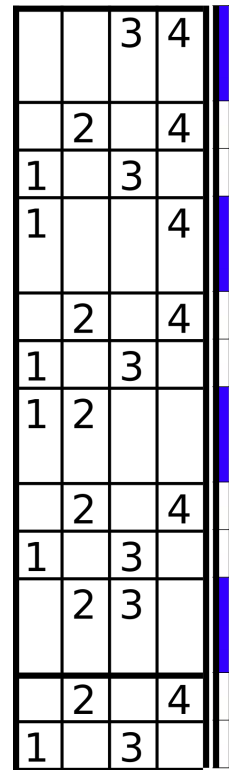
**Block order =
A x2, B x2, C x2, D x2**
