Treadling Shadow Fashion

Shadow Fashion / OVERSHOT DEPARTURES

Brief treadling instructions

1. Pattern (fine, twill shed)
2. Tabby (heavy, plain weave shed)
3. Pattern (fine, twill shed)
4. Tabby (heavy, plain weave shed)

Etc.

Treadling/liftplan instructions for each block

For looms with tie-ups, use [Tie-Up #1](#).

Note: it doesn't matter which tabby shed you start with as long as they alternate throughout.

To treadle Block A:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (fine weft) through the Block A twill shed (Shafts 1&2 down, Shafts 3&4 up = twill Treadle 1)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (heavy weft) through whichever plain weave shed was NOT used last.

To treadle Block B:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (fine weft) through the Block B twill shed (Shafts 2&3 down, Shafts 1&4 up = twill Treadle 2)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (heavy weft) through whichever plain weave shed was NOT used last.

To treadle Block C:

1. Throw the pattern shuttle (fine weft) through the Block C twill shed (Shafts 3&4 down, Shafts 1&2 up = twill Treadle 3)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (heavy weft) through whichever plain weave shed was NOT used last.



To treadle Block D:

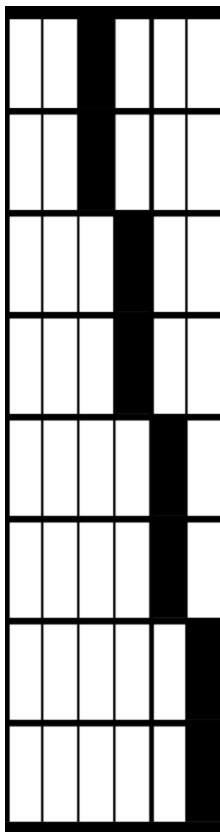
1. Throw the pattern shuttle (fine weft) through the Block D twill shed (Shafts 1&4 down, Shafts 2&3 up = twill Treadle 4)
2. Throw the tabby shuttle (heavy weft) through whichever plain weave shed was NOT used last.

Treading and liftplan diagrams

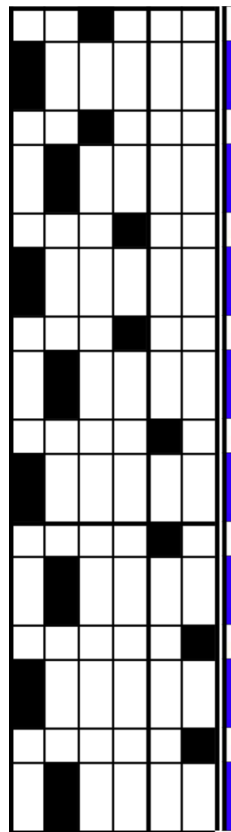
Each row of the treading block order represents two picks: one pattern and one tabby.

For looms with tie-ups, use [Tie-Up #1](#).

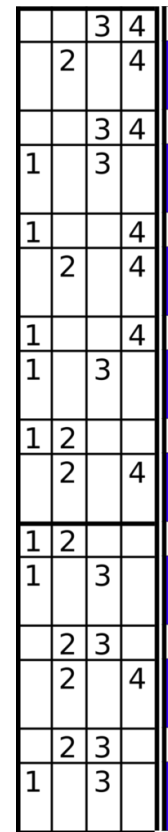
**Block order = A x2, B x2, C
x2, D x2**

Blue = tabby, white = pattern. That's reversed from normal!
