Star Fashion Drafts / OVERSHOT DEPARTURES



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Here are the star fashion treadlings and the equivalent liftplans for each of the three suggested threadings.

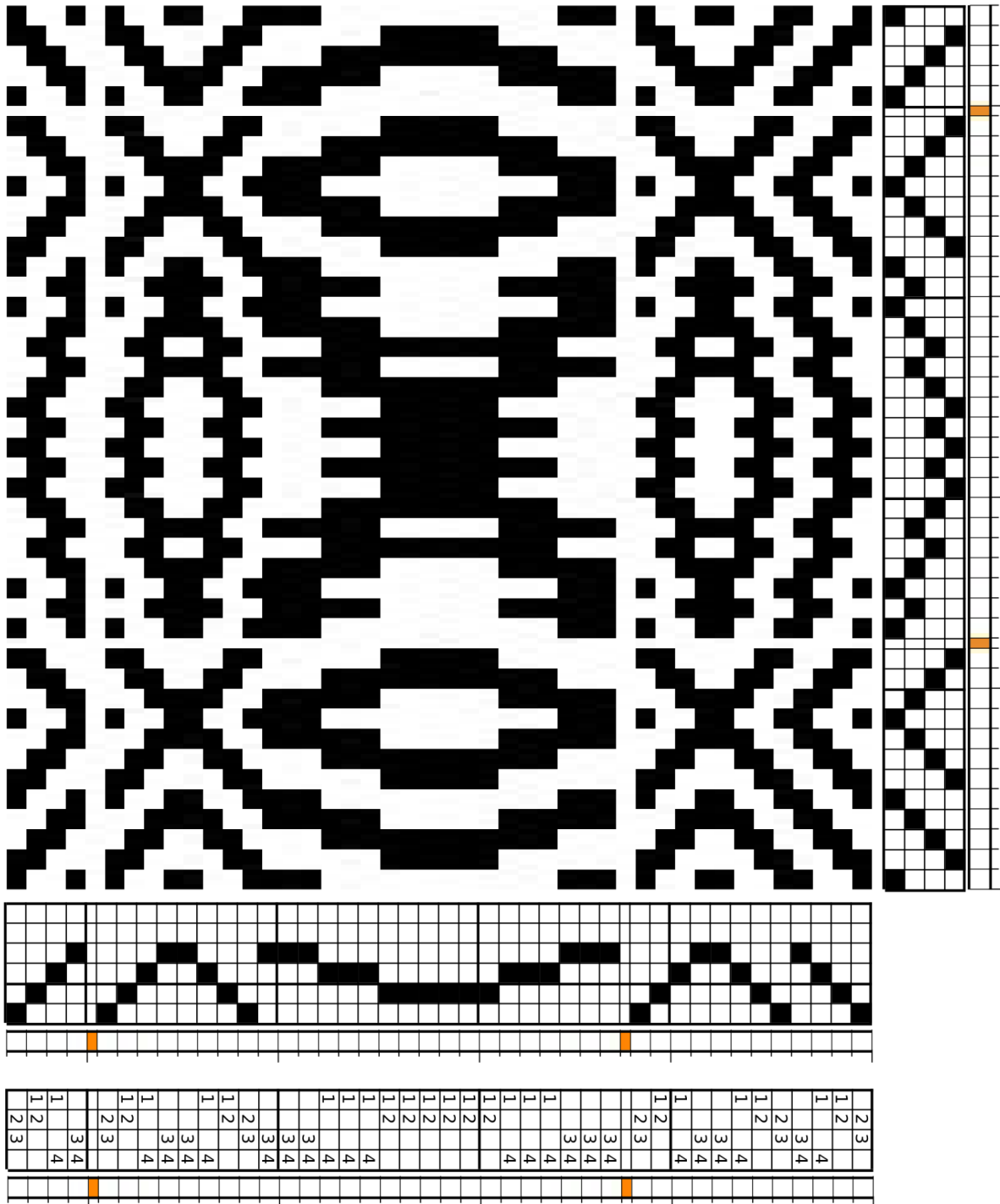
Before you look at the treadlings and drawdowns, **PLEASE NOTE:**

- The slight gaps in the threading and the treadling are the breaks between border, repeat, and balance. **The repeat is the section between the orange markers.** The orange is only to mark repeats; it doesn't signify anything about weft color.
- As with nearly all standard overshot drafts, there is no tabby included in the treadling or liftplans. **You should still follow the rules for the standard overshot treadling system while weaving.**
- You can use the treadling or liftplan given for your threading whether you've got "samples" or "runners" borders threaded.

Repeat the section between the orange lines as desired. Use [Tie-Up #1](#) with treadingling.

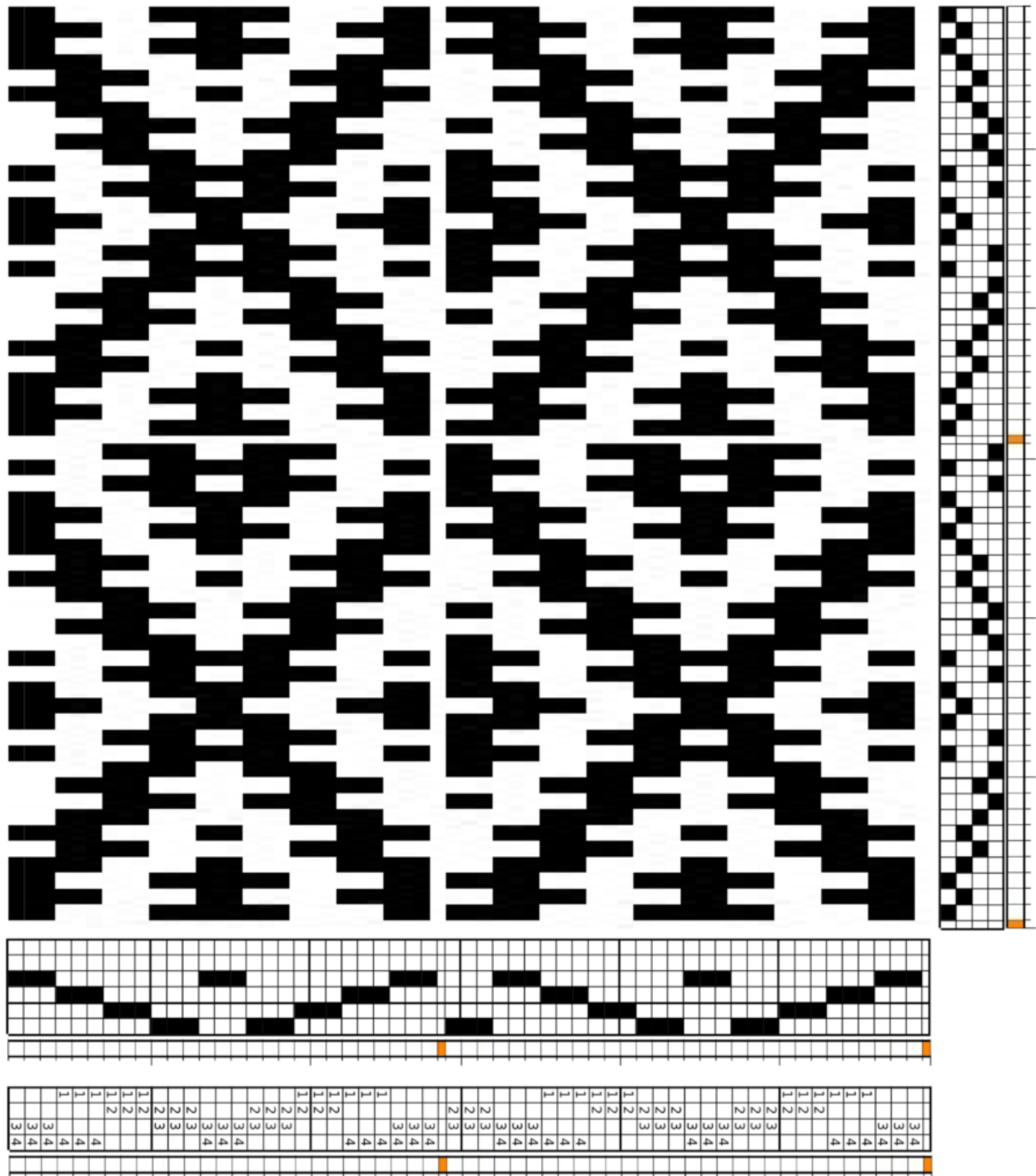

Diamonds star fashion treadingling (filled) & liftplan (numeric)

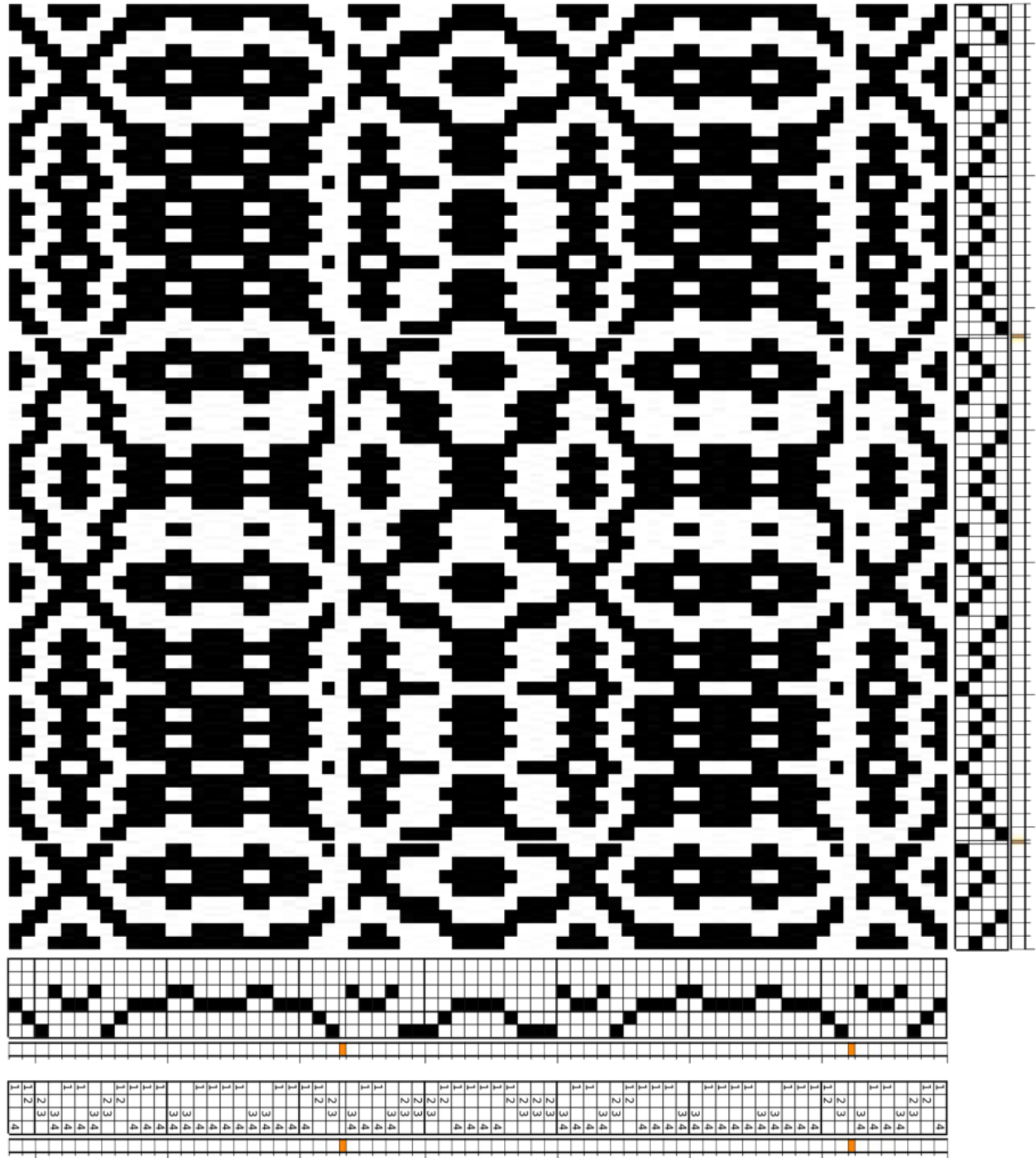
