Woven on Opposites

Woven on Opposites / OVERSHOT DEPARTURES

Brief treadling instructions

1. Pattern 1/leader (a twill shed)
2. Pattern 2/follower (opposite twill shed)
3. Pattern 1/leader (a twill shed)
4. Pattern 2/follower (opposite twill shed)

Treadling/liftplan instructions for each block

For looms with tie-ups, use [Tie-Up #1](#).

To treadle Block A:

1. Throw the leading pattern shuttle through the Block A twill shed
(Shafts 1&2 down, Shafts 3&4 up = twill Treadle 1)
2. Throw the following pattern shuttle through the Block C twill shed
(Shafts 3&4 down, Shafts 1&2 up = twill Treadle 3)

To treadle Block B:

1. Throw the leading pattern shuttle through the Block B twill shed
(Shafts 2&3 down, Shafts 1&4 up = twill Treadle 2)
2. Throw the following shuttle through the Block D twill shed
(Shafts 1&4 down, Shafts 2&3 up = twill Treadle 4)

To treadle Block C:

1. Throw the leading pattern shuttle through the Block C twill shed
(Shafts 3&4 down, Shafts 1&2 up = twill Treadle 3)
2. Throw the following pattern shuttle through the Block A twill shed
(Shafts 1&2 down, Shafts 3&4 up = twill Treadle 1)



To treadle Block D:

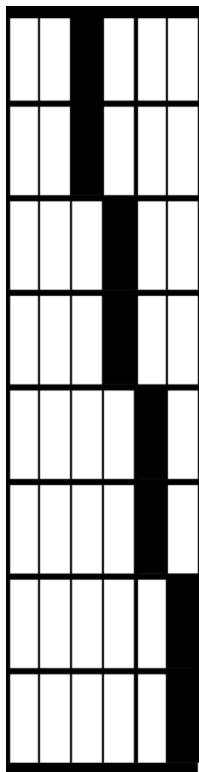
1. Throw the leading pattern shuttle through the Block D twill shed
(Shafts 1&4 down, Shafts 2&3 up = twill Treadle 4)
2. Throw the following pattern shuttle through the Block B twill shed
(Shafts 2&3 down, Shafts 1&4 up = twill Treadle 2)

Treading and liftplan diagrams

Each row of the treading block order represents two picks: one of pattern 1 and one of pattern 2.

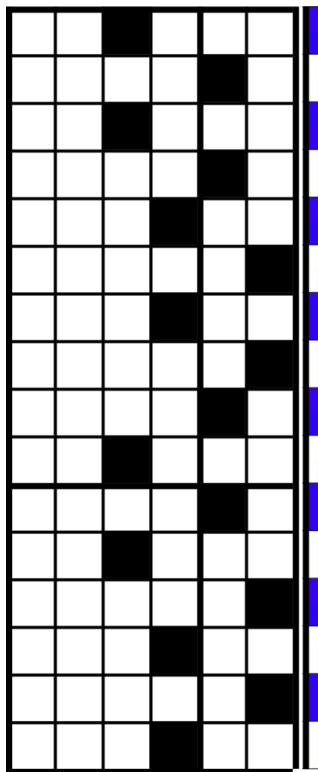
For looms with tie-ups, use [Tie-Up #1](#).

Block order =
A x2, B x2, C x2, D x2



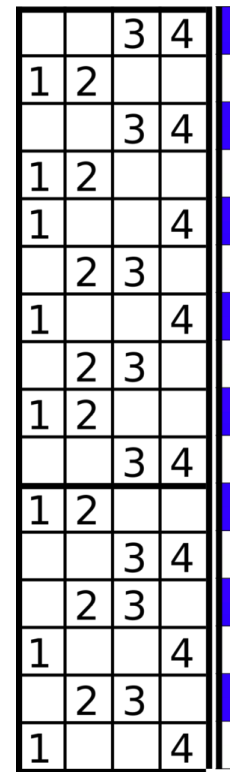
Each row of block order
equates to two picks: one
of each pattern weft
